WHAT IS IT?

The Neonatal Resuscitation Program (NRP) – 7th Edition is an educational program jointly sponsored with the American Heart Association (AHA). The course has been designed to teach an evidence-based approach to resuscitation of the newborn to hospital staff who care for newborns at the time of delivery, including physicians, nurses and respiratory therapists. The current edition is based on simulation methodology, enhancing development of critical leadership, communication, and teamwork skills.



All NRP courses are self-study with online testing prior to scenario skills testing.
