

ACLS - Advanced Cardiac Life Support 2017 Course

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course is designed to prepare healthcare professionals to effectively respond to respiratory and cardiac arrest. Scenarios are developed to assist the participant in:

- Identification and treatment of medical conditions putting the patient at risk for cardiac arrest
- Reinforcement of Basic Life Support skills
- ACLS Algorithms/Megacodes
- Team dynamics in a resuscitative environment

- ACLS EP for Experienced Providers ONLY (ED, ICU, etc.)
- Current BLS Provider card
- Successful completion of a Basic Dysrhythmia Course or equivalent
