

PALS - Pediatric Advanced Life Support 2017 Course

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course is designed to prepare healthcare professionals to effectively respond to respiratory and cardiac arrest in the pediatric population. Scenarios are developed to assist the participant in:

- Identification and treatment of medical conditions putting the pediatric patient at risk for cardiac arrest
- Reinforcement of Children and Infant Basic Life Support skills
- PALS Algorithms/Megacodes
- Team Dynamics in a Resuscitative Environment

- Successful completion of a Basic Dysrhythmia Course or equivalent
